




Then the Lord adds: - The ghost lives in a secret room in the castle. At night he walks around the house making terrible noises and scaring everyone!


- We are American: we don't believe in ghosts! - says Mr Otis.

"They will be scared to death and they will leave the house to me!" he thinks.


He goes around the house rattling the chains. When he arrives in front of Mr Otis's bedroom, he shakes the chains, wailing and moaning.

Then he adds: - A prophecy says that God will forgive me if a good person prays for the salvation of my soul.


- I will pray for you - says Virginia. While she is praying, the ghost feels a great peace in his heart. He closes his eyes and dies.
